

Guided by the Holy Spirit

Kids "pin the heart on the cross," guided by the voices of their classmates as they remember that faith leads to love.

Supplies:

- Large cross
- Masking tape
- Scissors
- Construction paper
- Blindfold

Set Up:

Hang or post the cross on a classroom wall in an open area of your room.
Cut heart shapes from construction paper.

Instructions:

Jesus promises that the Holy Spirit will always with be us. The Holy Spirit can guide our decisions and our actions, and it can remind us every day of God's love for all of us. Sometimes, having faith means letting the Holy Spirit guide our hearts. Let's play a trust game. You'll have to trust your family/friends to guide you as you try to bring your heart to the cross.

1. Gently blindfold the first volunteer.
2. Give the volunteer a heart cutout with a rolled piece of masking tape on the back. Spin the player around a few times.
3. Choose someone else to guide the player to the cross with verbal directions.
4. When the first player is done, blindfold a second player. Ask the first player to verbally guide the second player.
5. Continue playing until each kid has had a chance to guide and follow.

It takes a lot of faith to trust someone to guide you, but we can have faith in our friends. Remember, faith leads to love!

If you have less time . . .

Give each kid a chance to guide or follow, but not both.

If you have more time . . .

Set up obstacles in the room that the kids must maneuver around on their way to the cross.
