

## "God's Place For Me" Diorama

Kids create dioramas as they remember that God has a place for me.

### Supplies:

- Empty cereal boxes
- Paper
- Scissors
- Marker (adult use only)
- Kid-friendly magazines
- Glue sticks
- Crayons
- Stickers (optional)
- Smaller boxes (optional)

### Set Up:

Cut one side from each box to create a space for a diorama.

Pre-print strips of paper with the phrase "God has a place for me!" One per kid.

### Instructions:

**God has a place for all of us, in this world and in heaven.**

**We don't know what kind of place God has for us, but Jesus said there will be room in God's house for all of us.**

**Try to imagine what you think a perfect room would be for you.**

1. Pass out magazines, scissors, and glue sticks.
2. Invite kids to look through magazines. **Cut out anything might want to have in a room that's all your own.**
3. Direct kids to glue pictures onto the insides of their boxes.
4. Invite them to add more details with crayons.
5. Ask kids to glue the pre-printed strips of paper to their room artwork to finish.

**The disciples knew that they could live in God's house, and we know that we can, too! Jesus is the way to God's house. Let's follow him!**

If you have less time . . .

Provide paper, crayons, and a selection of stickers. Invite kids to draw a picture and add stickers to show what kinds of things they would like in a room of their very own.

If you have more time . . .

Instead of cereal boxes, provide kids with several smaller boxes each (pudding mix boxes work well). Invite them to create rooms for their family or friends. Then, glue boxes together at the side to make a building with several rooms.
